

Jordan Visa process

- Process: Korean nationals visiting Jordan can obtain a visa upon arrival at the airport or any major land border crossing.
- Fee: The cost of a visa on arrival is JOD 40, or roughly USD 56. If you are not entering from the airports, you must also pay an exit tax of JOD 10 at the border.

• Transportation in Jordan

Getting around Jordan is relatively convenient, with several transportation options available:

Taxi: taxis are readily available in major cities and can be hailed on the street or arranged through your accommodation. Ensure the meter is used or agree on a fare before the journey. Other alternatives such as Uber and Careem offer services similar to taxis that are affordable and can be called

via mobile application.

Public Buses: The public bus system connects different regions of Jordan, offering an affordable way to travel. Check the schedules and routes in advance.

Rental Cars: Renting a car provides flexibility, especially if you plan to explore remote areas. International driving licenses are generally accepted, and road signs are in Arabic and English.

→ **Description:** The dishdasha is typically made of lightweight, breathable fabric such as cotton or linen. It is a loose-fitting robe that drapes from the shoulders to the ankles, providing comfort in the region's warm climate.

- → Design & Features: The dishdasha usually has long sleeves and a collarless neckline. It is commonly found in solid colors, with white being a popular choice. Some dishdashas may feature subtle embroidery or embellishments along the neckline, cuffs, or front.
- → Cultural significance: The dishdasha represents the cultural heritage of Jordan and the Arabian Peninsula. It is worn for various occasions, including formal events, religious ceremonies, and everyday attire.



- → **Description:** The thobe is an ankle-length dress that is loose-fitting an provides modesty and comfort. It is typically made of lightweight fabric, often with delicate embroidery or decorative patterns.
- → Design & Features: The thobe varies in design and style depending on the region and personal preference. It is commonly characterized by long sleeves, a high neckline, and flowing fabric. The dress may be adorned with intricate embroidery, sequins, or colorful patterns.
